



Event and Outing Guide



Thank you in advance for allowing us to assist you with your upcoming event. The entire staff of City Club Marietta is eager to ensure that your event will be the best experience of golf that we can provide. City Club Marietta prides itself in conducting and coordinating professional quality events with a personal touch to provide you with a day of fun and enjoyment that is unmatched. We will guarantee that all of your guests will be treated as though each and every one is our personal member for a day.

During the planning and execution process, many questions will arise. We plan on assisting you with each and every one. If you have any concerns, please feel free to call us. Every detail will be addressed so you can have the assurance that your event will go off without a hitch.

We have established the following rules of play for tournaments, special events, and also regular public play. You are asked to please follow these simple rules. If you have any questions concerning any of these please feel free to ask. Thank you for joining us at City Club Marietta and we hope you enjoy your day of golf.

1. The tournament format must be approved by City Club Marietta.
2. We ask that groups have no more than 4 players per group.
3. The representative of the event group will be responsible for any damage to the golf course or golf course property.
4. Metal spikes are not permitted on the property.
5. Each player must have his or her own clubs. Rental clubs are available upon request.
6. We require a shirt with a collar when golfing. Cut offs, tank tops, screen printed t-shirts, or jogging attire is not permitted. An expanded dress code is available upon request.
7. Personal coolers may not be brought on the property. Coolers are available upon request from the grill.
8. Individuals may not bring alcoholic beverages on the property. Any alcohol purchased at our facility must remain on our property.
9. We ask each guest to please adhere to our cart path rules of the day.
10. City Club Marietta reserves the right to limit and/or deny groups from bringing their own food or beverages to the facility. A corkage fee may be required. Please contact the Food and Beverage Director prior to making arrangements.

All details concerning your event are presented on the event contract. These accommodations include your event date, number of players, price per player, time of your event, and event coordinator contact information.

Nestled among rolling hills and tall pines, and just a stone's throw from the Historic Marietta Square, City Club Marietta gives the golfing public the flavor of a mountain course. While offering spectacular vistas, City Club Marietta requires excellent shot-making and accurate putting on bent grass greens. Our course is adjacent to the Marietta Conference Center & Resort located at 510 Powder Springs Street, Marietta, GA 30064. Our mission is to provide golfers and visitors with the best customer service and playing experience of any course in the golf industry.

Marietta is rich with history and included in this history is City Club Marietta. The original nine-hole layout was designed by members of the Marietta Country Club and constructed on the former site of the Georgia Military Institute around 1912. That original layout included holes that encircled the clubhouse and ran along Powder Springs Street. An additional nine holes was added in the early 1960's. The property was bought by the City of Marietta and after an extensive renovation by Mike Young Designs, the course was opened to the public in the fall of 1991.



Conduct

We expect all guests to observe proper conduct during their visit. City Club Marietta reserves the right to eject, or cause to be ejected from the premises any individuals behaving in an objectionable manner. City Club Marietta will not be liable for any damages that might be incurred through the exercising of this right.

Damage/Liability

The event coordinator and/or group will be responsible for any damage to the facility or golf course from any of its members or guests as a result of gross negligence, willful misconduct, alcohol, or theft.

Food/Alcohol

City Club Marietta reserves the right to limit and/or deny groups from bringing their own food or beverages to the facility. In the event that items are allowed to be brought onto the premises, all items must be turned in to the City Club Marietta at least 2 days prior to the event to be inventoried. All items must be served by our personnel. No person shall be served alcohol under the age of 21. City Club Marietta reserves the right to deny alcohol to individuals if warranted. Special situations may be discussed with the Food and Beverage Manager. All unused items must remain on the premises at the completion of the event.



Outing/Event Information

Golf outings are defined as groups of 16 or more players; however it is possible to set up an outing package for smaller groups. Golf outings are eligible for a shotgun start, modified shotgun start or tee times start. Please contact the City Club tournament staff to see which format would best suit your group. City Club Marietta does not offer golf outings for large tournament groups on weekends or holidays. We do require a minimum of 100 players in order to have an afternoon shotgun start event. Any groups that have an afternoon start and require the course to be closed to the public the day of the event will be required to pay for a minimum of 100 players.

Our outing packages all include green fee, cart fee, range balls, a food and beverage credit of \$7.00 per person, and a pro shop merchandise credit of \$7.00 per person. Also, we will prepare the golf carts with player's names, rules sheets, and team scorecards. Prior to the start of the event, announcements will be made regarding the rules of the day, starting methods and special notes in relation to your event. At the completion of play, we will have a scoreboard set up to allow us to score the event and award prizes.

We will also be happy to plan any requests you might have regarding food and beverages for your group. Depending upon the time of your event, arrangements can be made prior to or at the completion of your event. Our event coordinator will assist you with scheduling your agenda, deciding upon the format, creating rules sheets and selecting prizes. We will administer everything from setting up the closest-to-the-pin and long drive contests, to staging your golf carts in fleet formation with all players names and hole assignments, to synchronizing modified shotgun starts. Our detail-oriented coordinators will make sure that your event is everything you want it to be and much, much more!

Deposit

A deposit of 20% of the estimated total for the event or \$500.00 whichever is least, will be required to secure the date of your event. If your golf event is cancelled at least 10 days prior to the scheduled date of the event, your deposit may be refunded. The deposit may be paid by credit card, check or cash. If paying by credit card, you may either provide us the card information in person or you may fill out a credit card authorization form if you are not present. The required credit card authorization form is located in your event package. Payment in full is expected on the day of the event.

Rental Clubs

Golf club rentals are available upon request for a fee of \$40.00 per set. We have top of the line equipment for rent. Please let us know if the rentals will be paid for by the event group or if you would rather the individual guests pay for their own.



Hole-In-One-Service

Our staff can provide contacts for professional organizations that are experts in providing “Hole-In-One” opportunities and include insurance coverage for such claims. These opportunities can include prizes up to and including automobiles and fabulous vacation packages to resort locations.

Final Count/Guarantee Policy

A final count of participants must be submitted to the City Club Marietta at least seven (7) days in advance of the event. This guarantee may not be reduced after this time and you will be required to pay for that number of participants.

Player Information/ Player Pairings

To have a successful and professionally run event, we must have complete player information on each golfer two (2) days prior to the event. Player information should include: names (both first and last), handicaps (if applicable), and pairing group requests. All play on the course will be in groups of no more than four players. At no time do we allow five players in a group. Having the correct player information ahead of time allows us to provide cart signs, hole assignments, and customer service when loading golf bags. We are here to assist in the success of your golf event.

Beverage Cart Service

For your convenience, we have a fully stocked beverage cart available while on the golf course. Our beverage cart is stocked with everything from an assortment of non-alcoholic beverages, beer, and cocktail mixers to snacks. If you desire any “special” items, please give our event coordinators advance notice so we can accommodate you.

Bag Valet Services

Our friendly golf cart attendants will gladly unload your golf bag and place it on a golf cart that has your name, tee time, and hole assignment posted in a clear view. For your convenience, our attendants will help coordinate and assist your guests. When you’re finished, our staff will clean your golf clubs and place them in your vehicle as you depart.



Professional Golf Instruction & Golf Clinics

Add a golf instruction clinic to your next golf outing! City Club Marietta employs PGA Professionals who will conduct all pre-tournament clinics. These clinics/presentations are entertaining and informative. We can accommodate any number of participants on any subject matter that you choose. For your convenience, our most requested programs are listed below. We look forward to helping you with your game and making your event both memorable and enjoyable. These clinics are hands on and involve both the PGA Teaching Professionals and the participants.

Our most popular programs:

Putting Clinic- Includes introduction of putting fundamentals, alignment, speed control and reading greens.

Chipping Clinic- Includes introduction of chipping and use of wedges. Introduces technique and understanding of power to create more consistency around the green.

Driver Clinic- This clinic includes an introduction of the fundamentals and technique of the “Big Stick”. Alignment, set-up and attitude help the performance of the Driver.

Moving the Ball Left and Right- Includes introduction of the use of club path and club face to create controlled movement of the ball.

Other Suggestions

We can provide items to add a special touch to your next tournament by adding your company logo or any monogram. Please give us advance notice if you are interested in providing these items to your guests. As much as 7-8 weeks notice may be required. The professional staff can assist with your requests. Some popular items are listed below:

Clothing: Golf shirts, wind shirts, hats and visors.

Golf Balls: Logo balls(most brands available). Special ball packaging is available to match your company or tournament logo.

Gift Boxes: Gift boxes such as ball sets with ball mark repair tools, tees, bag tags, etc.

Golf Shoes: Special FootJoy tournament shoe program.

Accessories: Custom bag tag, logo towels, umbrellas, divot tools, etc.

Clubs: Drivers, wedges, putters, etc.

Specialty Items: Cigars or high-quality pictures of each group. These photos are produced by one of our suppliers and are handed out at the completion of your event. The pictures can come complete and in a small frame. We can also provide awards including trophies, wood plaques, glass awards, and a variety of other items. Several weeks notice is required for personalized trophies and awards.

Dress Code Policy

The dress code policy is enforced with guests on the property including the driving range and the golf course.

Men

A shirt with collar is required to use the facilities. A turtleneck or mock turtleneck shirt with a collar of at least 2 inches in height is also acceptable. Jeans are permitted. Shorts are permitted but must be hemmed (no cutoffs). T-shirts or jogging attire is not permitted. Golf shoes or sneakers are permitted, however hard soled street shoes or boots are not.

Ladies

Ladies are not required to wear a shirt with a collar, however screen printed T-shirts, halter-tops or jogging attire are not acceptable. Jeans are permitted. Shorts are permitted but must be hemmed. Skirts or skorts are also permitted. Golf shoes or sneakers are permitted, however hard soled street shoes or boots are not.

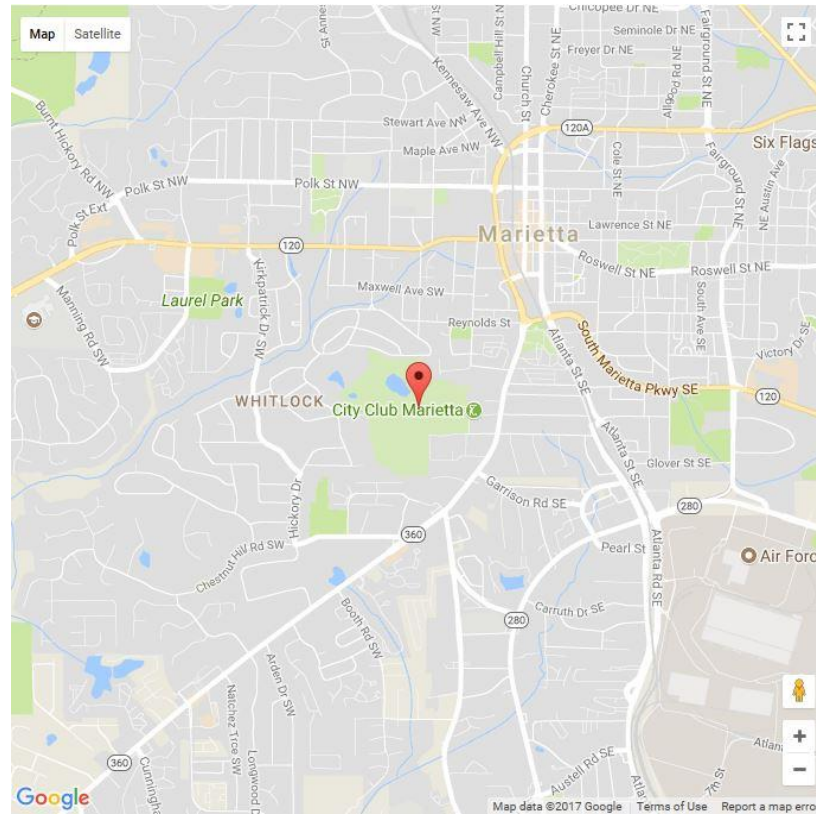
City Club Marietta is an alternative spike facility. The use of steel or ceramic spikes is prohibited.

Guests Under the Age of 12

A shirt with a collar is not required, however T-shirts or jogging attire are not acceptable. Jeans are permitted. Shorts are permitted but must be hemmed. Golf shoes or sneakers are permitted, however hard soled street shoes or boots are not.

Directions

From I-75 take exit 263(120 South Loop), go west 3.5 miles to Powder Springs Street(360), turn left, approximately 1/4 mile on the right, turn into the entrance of the Marietta Conference Center & Resort. The City Club Marietta clubhouse is to the left of the hotel. Bag drop facilities and additional parking are available in the rear of the clubhouse.
